

IBMM PARENTS' ROOM – Guidelines

Purpose and Use of Room

A Parents' Room has been established at the IBMM for the use of students and staff requiring a place to attend to specific needs of young children and parents (Meeting room 233, second floor, Bühlstrasse 28, 3012 Bern).

The room provides:

- a quiet place to breastfeed, bottle feed or express milk privately
- comfortable seating
- baby change table
- waste disposal
- (• water tap available in the hallway)

The area is available for male and female members of the institute community with responsibility for caring for infants or young children as well as for breastfeeding mothers.

Students and staff using the room must maintain appropriate standards of hygiene and cleanliness and clean the facilities they use each time they use the room.

Access to the room

The Parents Room is mainly used as regular meeting room. Whenever the room is needed, it needs to be looked from the inside to ensure privacy (leaving the key in the door). Please access the room only from the hallway door and make sure to check the availability on the room reservation list.



Parents retain ultimate responsibility for the supervision and safety of children in their care. They must ensure supervision of children at all times.
